### Prestonville Friend

MP said that St Luke's is going to take on the *Prestonville Friend*, with the deadline for the next issue as 21 March, for distribution early April.

St Luke's are also going to be revamping their website to make it more social-media friendly. They will have a separate (linked) website for *Prestonville Friend*.

**JK** to write an article underlining that one of the functions of the PCA is to foster a sense of community, and inviting people to become street reps, with the primary role of welcoming people on behalf of the community. (The existing list of distributors for the PF could also be asked if they would take on that role.)

### Welcome Pack

Each street rep would be supplied with a Welcome Pack to hand out to new residents. **MP** to create a document listing all the things related to the Church and pass it to **JK** and who will add to it.

It will have prestonville.org.uk at the top. And all the information contained within it will also be put on the PCA website.

It was agreed that the PCA website would also have an introductory panel explaining the purpose of the PCA. **JK** to write and circulate before asking Peter Golton to adjust the website to include this.

**JK** also to add the Book Group and FoDRP events to the calendar.

### Community media.

MK had suggested the idea of a community podcast in which people talked informally about local life. It would present a range of local voices; to provide this variety a group of people would have to be involved in producing it.
